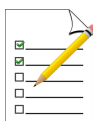

What we are learning:

Math:

I can recognize area as an attribute of plane figures and understand concepts of area measurement. I can measure area by counting unit squares and relate area to the operations of multiplication and addition.

Science:

I can measure and estimate liquid volumes and masses of objects using standard units of grams, kilograms, and liters. I can solve one-step work problems involving masses or volumes.

ELA:

I can describe parts of a play and how each part builds on the next. I can use possessive nouns to show ownership. I can write a Folktale.

Social Studies:

I can explain the key reasons the colonies were founded. I can compare and contrast colonial life in the different regions. I can describe the perspectives of the various people of the colonies. I can explain how the geography of the land helped the colonial people.
